- Conduct internationally comparative research on a key health care delivery or policy issue
- Develop a network for ongoing cross-national exchange and collaboration

Who should apply to the fellowship?

- Policymakers, clinicians, researchers, health care executives, and journalists committed to advancing health policy and practice
- People from historically marginalized backgrounds and/or populations underrepresented in these fields
- Mid-career professionals for whom the experience is likely to have a significant impact on career trajectory
- Established residents of **Canada, France, Germany, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Singapore, and the United Kingdom*** who are eligible
