

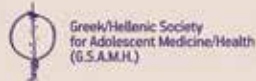

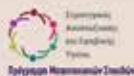

We hope you will also use your time in Athens to visit famous museums and monuments, and to explore nearby cultural destinations, such as Sounion, Delphi and Nafplion-Epidaurus, that will further enrich your experience.
